The Oregon Health Network is made up of hospitals and healthcare systems, rural health clinics, FQHCs, community health centers, community mental health centers, tribal clinics and community colleges. It was created to address the need for a seamless telehealth network throughout the state of Oregon for healthcare delivery and healthcare education. The goals of the OHN are to: 1. help create parity in health services across urban, suburban and rural regions of Oregon; 2. expand telehealth applications in underserved areas; 3. enable active participation of rural healthcare providers in telehealth applications; and 4. create a statewide broadband network that improves access to high quality healthcare in Oregon .

The network will be an Internet Protocol data network. It will connect the existing hospital networks as well as other sites not currently connected to an existing network at the Northwest Access Exchange (NWAX). At NWAX the network will be connected to I2 and for NLR depending upon the outcome of the competitive bidding process. The capacity should be scalable to meet future needs with quality guaranteed for real-time applications such as video consultation. A Network Operations Center (NOC) will be contracted to provide monitoring and support. Two new regional internet exchanges (RIEs) will be provide services for local traffic. The network will be bid in a series of RFPs issued in both Funding Years 2008 and 2009. The first RFP is included in this posting - it includes the NOC services, services from the new local exchanges (RIEs) and the connection to I2/NLR. It also includes one rural hospital and 2 community colleges and some of their branch campuses. We estimate that the five remaining RFPs planned for 2008 will represent 50% of the total project and the 3 RFPs scheduled for 2009 will cover the remaining 35% of the project.


